RESOLUTION

Expressing the support and sympathy of the House of Representatives and the people of the United States for the victims of the tragic fire that occurred in Ordway, Colorado, on April 16, 2008.

Whereas on April 15, 2008, flames broke out in Ordway, Colorado;

Whereas the fire spread quickly due to strong winds, taking the lives of 2 volunteer firefighters, John Schwartz and Terry Devore;

Whereas all 1,200 residents of Ordway were ordered to flee from their homes;

Whereas firefighters, paramedics, police officers, and other emergency personnel, along with Crowley County school, the Crowley County Nursing Center, and the County

Government worked courageously to move people to safety and rescue the injured and extinguish the fire; and

Whereas the outpouring of support, assistance, and compassion from Coloradans is greatly appreciated: Now, therefore, be it
