A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Trade Act of 1978 to reauthorize the market access program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MARKET ACCESS PROGRAM.**

4 Section 211(c)(1)(A) of the Agricultural Trade Act
5 of 1978 (7 U.S.C. 5641(c)(1)(A)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “and” before “\$200,000,000”;
7 and

8 (2) by inserting “and \$325,000,000 for each of
9 fiscal years 2008 through 2012,” after “2007,”.

1 **SEC. 2. FOREIGN MARKET DEVELOPMENT COOPERATOR**
2 **PROGRAM.**

3 Section 703 of the Agricultural Trade Act of 1978
4 (7 U.S.C. 5723) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)—

6 (A) by striking “\$34,500,000” and insert-
7 ing “\$50,000,000”; and

8 (B) by striking “2002 through 2007” and
9 inserting “2008 through 2012”; and

10 (2) in subsection (b), in the matter preceding
11 paragraph (1), by striking “2001” and inserting
12 “2007”.
