A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON IMPOSITION OF CERTAIN PEN-**
2 **ALTIES UNDER TANF.**

3 Notwithstanding subpart F of part 261 and part 262
4 of title 45, Code of Federal Regulations (relating to State
5 work verification plans required under the Temporary As-
6 sistance for Needy Families program) or any other provi-
7 sion of law, the Secretary of Health and Human Services
8 shall not reduce the State family assistance grant payable
9 to a State for a fiscal year under section 403(a) of the
10 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 603(a)), or otherwise im-
11 pose a penalty against a State for failure to comply with
12 subsection (a) or (i)(2) of section 407 of the Social Secu-
13 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 607) with respect to months beginning
14 after September 2006 and before the end of the 12-month
15 period that begins on the date the Secretary notifies the
16 State that the work verification plan submitted by the
17 State pursuant to subpart F of part 261 of title 45, Code
18 of Federal Regulations, satisfies the requirements of such
19 subpart.

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
