# A BILL

3       **SECTION 1. DR. KARL E. CARSON POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4       (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

5       Postal Service located at 301 Boardwalk Drive in Fort

6       Collins, Colorado, shall be known and designated as the

7       “Dr. Karl E. Carson Post Office Building”.

8       (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-

9       ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the "Dr. Karl E. Carson  
3 Post Office Building".
