AN ACT

To delay for 6 months the requirement to use of tamper-resistant prescription pads under the Medicaid program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Patient and Pharmacy
3 Protection Act of 2007”.

4 SEC. 2. 6-MONTH DELAY IN REQUIREMENT TO USE TAM-
5 PER-RESISTANT PRESCRIPTION PADS UNDER
6 MEDICAID.

7 Effective as if included in the enactment of section
8 7002(b) of the U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care,
9 Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations
10 Act, 2007 (Public Law 110-28, 121 Stat. 187), paragraph
11 (2) of such section is amended by striking "September 30,
12 2007" and inserting "March 31, 2008".
