To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend increased expensing for small businesses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF INCREASED EXPENSING FOR

4 SMALL BUSINESSES.

5 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 179 of the Internal Rev-
6 enue Code of 1986 (relating to election to expense certain
7 depreciable business assets) is amended by striking
8 “2010” each place it appears and inserting “2011”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 December 31, 2009.
