3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

5 in Santa Fe, New Mexico, shall be known and designated
6 as the “Santiago E. Campos United States Courthouse”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the United

- 1 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
- 2 to be a reference to the “Santiago E. Campos United
- 3 States Courthouse”.
