## A BILL

To require States and Indian tribes to designate specific highway routes over which hazardous materials may be transported.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIAL**  
4               **ROUTES.**

5       Section 5112(a)(2) of title 49, United States Code,  
6       is amended—

7               (1) by striking “subsection (d) of this section”  
8       and inserting “subsection (f)”;

- 1           (2) by striking “of this title” and inserting “,
- 2           and in accordance with the standards prescribed
- 3           under subsection (b),”; and
- 4           (3) by striking “may” and inserting “shall”.
