3 **SECTION 1. RULES OF ORIGIN FOR CERTAIN TEXTILE AND**
4 **APPAREL PRODUCTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 334(b)(2)(A)(i) of the
6 Uruguay Round Agreements Act (19 U.S.C.
7 3592(b)(2)(A)(i)) is amended by inserting “(except
8 6303.12.00 and 6303.92.20)” after “6303”.

9 (b) CERTAIN FINISHING OPERATIONS.—Section
10 334(b)(2)(C) of the Uruguay Round Agreements Act (19

1 U.S.C. 3592(b)(2)(C)) is amended by inserting “(except
2 goods classified under heading 6303.92.20)” after
3 “6303.92”.

4 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
5 subsections (a) and (b) apply to goods entered, or with-
6 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
7 date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment of
8 this Act.
