A BILL

To redesignate the Federal building located at 167 North Main Street in Memphis, Tennessee, as the “Clifford Davis and Odell Horton Federal Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 167 North Main
5 Street in Memphis, Tennessee, commonly known as the
6 Clifford Davis Federal Building, shall be known and des-
7 ignated as the “Clifford Davis and Odell Horton Federal
8 Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Clifford Davis and Odell Horton Fed-
6 eral Building”.
