Mr. SPECTER (for himself and Mr. COBURN) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

To amend the Standing Rules of the Senate to prohibit
filling the tree.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) rule XV of the Standing Rules of
2 the Senate is amended by adding at the end the following:

3 “6. Notwithstanding action on a first degree amend-
4 ment, it shall not be in order for a Senator to offer a sec-
5 ond degree amendment to his or her own first degree
6 amendment.”.

7 (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall take
8 effect at the beginning of the 111th Congress.
