3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ARMED FORCES OR-**
4 **GANIZATIONS FOR DONATIONS OF PERSONAL**
5 **PROPERTY THROUGH STATE AGENCIES.**

6 Section 549(c)(3)(B) of title 40, United States Code,
7 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (viii);

2 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause

3 (ix) and inserting “; or”; and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following new

5 clause:

6 “(x) An organization described in sec-

7 tion 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue

8 Code of 1986 (relating to a post or organi-

9 zation of past or present members of the

10 Armed Forces of the United States) and

11 exempt from taxation under section 501(a)

12 of such Code.”.

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
