Mr. ADLER of New Jersey (for himself, Mr. SMITH of New Jersey, Mr. ANDREWS, Mr. LOBIONDO, and Mr. HOLT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To ensure pay parity for Federal employees serving at Joint
Base McGuire/Dix/Lakehurst.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAY PARITY FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYEES SERV-**
4 **ING AT JOINT BASE MCGUIRE/DIX/**
5 **LAKEHURST.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of any determina-
7 tion of pay for an employee serving at Joint Base
8 McGuire/Dix/Lakehurst, the pay schedules and rates to be
9 used shall be the same as if such employee were serving

1 in the pay locality, wage area, or other area or locality
 2 (whichever would apply to determine pay for the employee
 3 involved) that includes Ocean County, New Jersey.

4 (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section—

5 (1) the term “employee” means an employee
 6 (as defined by section 2105 of title 5, United States
 7 Code)—

8 (A) whose pay is determined under sub-
 9 chapter III or IV of chapter 53 of such title; or

10 (B) who is paid from nonappropriated
 11 funds of any instrumentality of the United
 12 States;

13 (2) the term “pay locality” refers to a pay lo-
 14 cality under section 5302 of such title; and

15 (3) the term “wage area” refers to a wage area
 16 under section 5343 of such title.

17 (c) REGULATIONS.—The Office of Personnel Man-
 18 agement may prescribe any regulations necessary to carry
 19 out this Act.

20 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

21 This Act shall apply with respect to pay for service
 22 performed in any pay period beginning on or after the date
 23 of the enactment of this Act or October 1, 2009, whichever
 24 is later.
