1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. INCREASE IN NUMBER OF NON-DUAL STATUS  
4 TECHNICIANS EMPLOYABLE BY THE NA-  
5 TIONAL GUARD.

6 (a) FISCAL YEAR 2009 LIMITATION ON ARMY NA-  
7 TIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES TECHNICIANS.—  
8 Section 414(a)(1)(A) of the Duncan Hunter National De-  
9 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2009 (Public Law

1 110–417; 112 Stat. 4429) is amended by striking “1,600”  
2 and inserting “3,200”.

3 (b) PERMANENT LIMITATION ON NATIONAL GUARD  
4 TECHNICIANS.—Section 10217(c)(2) of title 10, United  
5 States Code, is amended by striking “1,950” and inserting  
6 “3,550”.
