2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VEHICLE MAINTENANCE BUILDING.**

4 The Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution
5 is authorized to plan, design, and construct a vehicle main-
6 tenance building at its Vehicle Maintenance Branch in
7 Suitland, Maryland, to house, maintain, and repair Smith-
8 sonian vehicles and transportation equipment.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 There are authorized to be appropriated \$4,000,000
3 for fiscal year 2010 for the purposes described in section
4 1.
