Mr. CASEY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on 11-Aminoundecanoic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 11-AMINOUNDECANOIC ACID.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.32.49 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 11-Aminoundecanoic acid) is amended—

7 (1) in the general rate of duty column, by strik-
8 ing “2.3%” and inserting “Free”; and

9 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
10 column and inserting “12/31/2012”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
5 this Act.
