A BILL

To extend and amend the temporary duty suspension on certain thin fiberglass sheets.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN FIBERGLASS SHEETS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.70.19 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) by striking “approximately .0125 inches
8 thick” and inserting “that are approximately 0.40
9 millimeters to 1.65 millimeters thick”; and

1 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
2 column and inserting “12/31/2011”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
4 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
