## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on 2-Chlorotoluene.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 2-CHLOROTOLUENE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Headings 9902.22.17 and  
5 9902.22.18 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
6 United States (relating to 2-Chlorotoluene) are each  
7 amended by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/  
8 2011”.

9       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
