A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain sports footwear.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN SPORTS FOOTWEAR.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Tennis shoes, basketball shoes, gym shoes, training shoes, and the like, the fore- going with outer soles of rub- ber or plastics (provided for in subheading 6402.99.31) ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
