## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain boots  
constructed by hand of natural rubber.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN BOOTS CONSTRUCTED BY HAND OF**  
4       **NATURAL RUBBER.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.08 of the Har-  
6       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7       certain boots constructed by hand of natural rubber) is  
8       amended by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/  
9       2011”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
