To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain used compression-ignition internal combustion piston engines used in remanufacture.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN USED COMPRESSION-IGNITION IN-**
4 **TERNAL COMBUSTION PISTON ENGINES**
5 **USED IN REMANUFACTURE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.31 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 certain used compression-ignition internal combustion pis-
9 ton engines used in remanufacture) is amended by striking

1 the date in the effective period column and inserting “12/
2 31/2011”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered or withdrawn from
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
