A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain AC electric motors of an output exceeding 37.5 W but not exceeding 72 W.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN AC ELECTRIC MOTORS OF AN OUT-**
4 **PUT EXCEEDING 37.5 W BUT NOT EXCEEDING**
5 **72 W.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.85.09 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 certain AC electric motors of an output exceeding 37.5
9 W but not exceeding 72 W) is amended by striking “12/
10 31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
