## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on alkylated melamine formaldehyde resin; melamine, formaldehyde polymer, methylated, butylated.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ALKYLATED MELAMINE FORMALDEHYDE**  
4                   **RESIN; MELAMINE, FORMALDEHYDE POLY-**  
5                   **MER, METHYLATED, BUTYLATED.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Alkylated melamine formaldehyde resin; melamine, formaldehyde polymer, methylated, butylated (CAS No. 68036-97-5) (provided for in subheading 3909.20.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1        (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
