3 **SECTION 1. 2-OXEPANONE POLYMER WITH 1,4-BUTANEDIOL**
4 **AND 5-ISOCYANATO-1-(ISOCYANATOMETHYL)–**
5 **1,3,3-TRIMETHYLCYCLOHEXANE, 2-ETHYL-1-**
6 **HEXANOL-BLOCKED.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.10 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 2-Oxepanone polymer with 1,4-butanediol and 5-
2 isocyanato-1-(isocyanatomethyl)-1,3,3-
3 trimethylcyclohexane, 2-ethyl-1-hexanol-blocked) is
4 amended by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/
5 2011”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.
