To suspend temporarily the duty on ultra-high molecular weight polyethylene yarn measuring not less than 131 decitex but not more than 340 decitex.

3 **SECTION 1. ULTRA-HIGH MOLECULAR WEIGHT POLY-**
4 **ETHYLENE YARN MEASURING NOT LESS**
5 **THAN 131 DECITEX BUT NOT MORE THAN 340**
6 **DECITEX.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
9 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
10 new heading:
