## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on mixtures of tris(4-isocyanatophenyl)thiophosphate and ethyl acetate and monochlorobenzene as solvents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF TRIS(4-**  
4 **ISOCYANATOPHENYL)THIOPHOSPHATE AND**  
5 **ETHYL ACETATE AND**  
6 **MONOCHLOROBENZENE AS SOLVENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.17 of the Har-  
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
9 mixtures of tris(4-isocyanatophenyl)thiophosphate and

1 ethyl acetate and monochlorobenzene as solvents) is  
2 amended by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/  
3 2011”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
5 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
6 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
7 the date of the enactment of this Act.
