3 **SECTION 1. BENZENE, 1,3-DIISOCYANATOMETHYL-, POLY-**
4 **MER WITH 1,6-DIISOCYANATOHEXANE DIS-**
5 **SOLVED IN N-BUTYL ACETATE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.18 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 benzene, 1,3-diisocyanatomethyl-, polymer with 1,6-

1 diisocyanatohexane dissolved in n-butyl acetate) is amend-
2 ed by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
