A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain hydration systems.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN HYDRATION SYSTEMS WITH A CARGO**
4 **STORAGE FROM 111 TO 700 CUBIC INCHES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Insulated hydration systems with an outer surface of textile materials whose interior incorporates a flexible plastic container of a kind for storing and dispensing potable beverages through attached flexible tubing and which have a cargo storage capacity from 111 through 700 cubic inches (provided for in sub-heading 4202.92.30)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
