## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain three-ring  
binders with small, built-in amplifiers.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN THREE-RING BINDERS WITH SMALL,**  
4                   **BUILT-IN AMPLIFIERS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Three-ring binders (provided for in subheading 6307.90.98) riveted to covers of polyester fabric, with a three-sided zipper closure for the main binder compartment, and having an exterior compartment composed of ethylene-vinyl acetate material covered in polyester fabric with a small, battery-operated amplifier .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
