## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on sound-isolating  
earphones.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2   *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SOUND-ISOLATING EARPHONES.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Sound-isolating earphones with multiple balanced armature speakers, each with non-porous slow-recovery black foam attachment sleeves, detachable cable, and with a repeatable frequency response of 20Hz or more but not over 16kHz with a deviation of +/ -3dB (provided for in sub-heading 8518.30.20) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
