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## A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty  
on certain sector mold press machines.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN SECTOR MOLD PRESS MACHINES.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.84.89 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       certain sector mold press machines) is amended—

7               (1) by striking the article description and in-  
8       serting the following: “Sector mold press machines,  
9       numerically controlled, the foregoing to be used in  
10      production of radial tires designed for off-the-high-

1 way use with a rim measuring 63.5 cm or more in  
2 diameter (provided for in subheading 4011.20.10,  
3 4011.61.00, 4011.63.00, 4011.69.00, 4011.92.00,  
4 4011.94.40, or 4011.99.45), and parts thereof (pro-  
5 vided for in subheading 8477.51.00 or 8477.90.85)”;  
6 and

7 (2) by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting  
8 “12/31/2011”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
10 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
11 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
12 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
