A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on certain men's footwear, valued over \$23/pair, not covering the ankle, with a coated or laminated textile fabric.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MEN'S FOOTWEAR, VALUED OVER \$23/**

4 **PAIR, NOT COVERING THE ANKLE, WITH A**

5 **COATED OR LAMINATED TEXTILE FABRIC.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.61 of the Har-

7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

8 certain men's footwear, valued over \$23/pair, not covering

1 the ankle, with a coated or laminated textile fabric) is

2 amended—

3 (1) by striking “\$20/pair” and inserting “\$23/

4 pair”; and

5 (2) by striking the date in the effective period

6 column and inserting “12/31/2011”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by

8 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

9 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

10 the date of the enactment of this Act.
