## A BILL

To provide assistance to Pakistan under certain conditions, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ASSISTANCE FOR PAKISTAN.**

4       Section 451 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961  
5       is amended by adding the following new subsection:

6       “(d)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
7       including subsection (a) of this section, the President is  
8       authorized to use funds made available to carry out the  
9       Millennium Challenge Act of 2003 (22 U.S.C. 7701 et  
10      seq.) and funds made available to carry out any provision

1 of this Act for assistance for Pakistan in an amount not  
2 to exceed \$500,000,000 if the President determines that  
3 to do so is in the vital national security interests of the  
4 United States.

5 “(2) The authority provided for in this subsection  
6 shall expire on September 30, 2010, and shall be subject  
7 to the requirements of subsections (a)(2) and (c) of this  
8 section.”.
