CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 any period of a fiscal year interim or full-year appropria-
2 tions for the personnel accounts of the Armed Forces have
3 not been enacted, or the Federal Government is unable
4 to make payments from such accounts because the public
5 debt limit under section 3101 of title 31, United States
6 Code, has been reached, Members of Congress, the Presi-
7 dent, and the Vice President should donate any salary re-
8 ceived for that period to the Treasury for purposes of re-
9 ducing the national debt.
