A BILL

To prohibit Members of Congress, including the Delegates and the Resident Commissioner to the Congress, and the President from receiving pay during Government shutdowns.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PAY DURING GOVERNMENT**
4 **SHUTDOWNS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Members of Congress and the
6 President shall not receive basic pay for any period in
7 which—

1 (1) there is more than a 24-hour lapse in ap-
2 appropriations for any Federal agency or department
3 as a result of a failure to enact a regular appropria-
4 tions bill or continuing resolution; or

5 (2) the Federal Government is unable to make
6 payments or meet obligations because the public
7 debt limit under section 3101 of title 31, United
8 States Code, has been reached.

9 (b) RETROACTIVE PAY PROHIBITED.—No pay for-
10 feited in accordance with subsection (a) may be paid retro-
11 actively.

12 (c) COVERAGE OF DELEGATES AND RESIDENT COM-
13 MISSIONER.—For purposes of this Act, the term “Member
14 of Congress” includes a Delegate or Resident Commis-
15 sioner to the Congress.
