A BILL

To prohibit the Environmental Protection Agency from regulating coal combustion byproducts as hazardous waste under subtitle C of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. NO REGULATION OF COAL COMBUSTION BY-**
2 **PRODUCTS AS HAZARDOUS WASTE UNDER**
3 **SUBTITLE C OF THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL**
4 **ACT.**

5 Section 3001(b)(3) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 6921(b)(3)) is amended by adding the fol-
7 lowing at the end thereof:

8 “(D) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph
9 (1) or any other provision of this paragraph, fly ash waste,
10 bottom ash waste, slag waste, and flue gas emission con-
11 trol waste generated primarily from the combustion of coal
12 shall not be subject to regulation under this subtitle.”.
