A BILL

To implement the recommendations of the report of the Government Accountability Office entitled “Opportunities to Reduce Potential Duplication in Government Programs, Save Tax Dollars, and Enhance Revenue”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPLEMENTATION OF GAO REPORT TO RE-**
4 **DUCE DUPLICATION IN GOVERNMENT PRO-**
5 **GRAMS.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, not later
7 than 150 days after the date of enactment of this Act,

1 the Director of the Office of Management and Budget
2 shall coordinate with the heads of the relevant department
3 and agencies to—

4 (1) use available administrative authority to
5 eliminate, consolidate, or streamline Government
6 programs and agencies with duplicative and overlap-
7 ping missions identified in the March 2011 Govern-
8 ment Accountability Office report to Congress enti-
9 tled “Opportunities to Reduce Potential Duplication
10 in Government Programs, Save Tax Dollars, and
11 Enhance Revenue” (GAO–11–318SP) and apply the
12 savings towards deficit reduction;

13 (2) identify and report to Congress any legisla-
14 tive changes required to further eliminate, consoli-
15 date, or streamline Government programs and agen-
16 cies with duplicative and overlapping missions identi-
17 fied in the March 2011 Government Accountability
18 Office report to Congress entitled “Opportunities to
19 Reduce Potential Duplication in Government Pro-
20 grams, Save Tax Dollars, and Enhance Revenue”
21 (GAO–11–318SP);

22 (3) determine the total cost savings that shall
23 result to each agency, office, and department from
24 the actions described in subsection (1); and

1 (4) rescind from the appropriate accounts the
2 amount greater of—

3 (A) \$5,000,000,000; or

4 (B) the total amount of cost savings esti-
5 mated by paragraph (3).

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
