Mr. CARDIN (for himself, Mr. WICKER, and Mrs. FEINSTEIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to expand the Operation Hero Miles program to include the authority to accept the donation of travel benefits in the form of hotel points or awards for free or reduced-cost accommodations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF OPERATION HERO MILES.**

4 (a) EXPANDED DEFINITION OF TRAVEL BENEFIT.—
5 Subsection (b) of section 2613 of title 10, United States
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1 “(b) TRAVEL BENEFIT DEFINED.—In this section,
2 the term ‘travel benefit’ means—

3 “(1) frequent traveler miles, credits for tickets,
4 or tickets for air or surface transportation issued by
5 an air carrier or a surface carrier, respectively, that
6 serves the public; and

7 “(2) points or awards for free or reduced-cost
8 accommodations issued by an inn, hotel, or other
9 commercial establishment that provides lodging to
10 transient guests.”.

11 (b) CONDITION ON AUTHORITY To ACCEPT DONA-
12 TION.—Subsection (c) of such section is amended—

13 (1) by striking “the air or surface carrier” and
14 inserting “the business entity referred to in sub-
15 section (b)”;

16 (2) by striking “the surface carrier” and insert-
17 ing “the business entity”; and

18 (3) by striking “the carrier” and inserting “the
19 business entity”.

20 (c) USE.—Subsection (d) of such section is amend-
21 ed—

22 (1) by striking “or” at the end of paragraph
23 (1);

24 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
25 graph (2) and inserting a semicolon; and

3 “(3) providing humanitarian support to mem-
4 bers and eligible beneficiaries receiving care through
5 the military health care system; and

6 “(4) providing support to allow participation of
7 members and their families in Department of De-
8 fense sponsored and authorized programs.”.

9 (d) ADMINISTRATION.—Subsection (e)(3) of such
10 section is amended by striking “the air carrier or surface
11 carrier” and inserting “the business entity referred to in
12 subsection (b)”.

13 (e) STYLISTIC AMENDMENTS.—

14 (1) SECTION HEADING.—The heading of such
15 section is amended to read as follows:

16 **“§ 2613. Acceptance of frequent traveler miles, cred-
17 its, points, and tickets: use to facilitate
18 rest and recuperation travel of deployed
19 members and their families, support
20 members and other beneficiaries of the
21 military health care system, and support
22 participation in authorized programs”.**

23 (2) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections
24 at the beginning of chapter 155 of such title is

1 amended by striking the item relating to section
2 2613 and inserting the following new item:

“2613. Acceptance of frequent traveler miles, credits, points, and tickets: use to facilitate rest and recuperation travel of deployed members and their families, support members and other beneficiaries of the military health care system, and support participation in authorized programs.”.
