A BILL

To modify the criteria used by the Corps of Engineers to dredge small ports.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF CORPS OF ENGINEERS CRI-
4 TERIA TO DREDGE SMALL PORTS.**

5 (a) MINIMUM TONNAGE REQUIREMENT.—Notwith-
6 standing any other provision of law (including regula-
7 tions), effective beginning on the date of enactment of this
8 Act, the tonnage requirement with respect to the consider-
9 ation of dredging of small ports by the Corps of Engineers

1 shall be a minimum of 500,000 tons, as calculated in ac-
2 cordance with subsection (b).

3 (b) CALCULATION.—For purposes of subsection (a)
4 and any other activity of the Corps of Engineers carried
5 out on or after the date of enactment of this Act, tonnage
6 shall be calculated by each relevant port authority and
7 submitted to the Corps of Engineers.
