Mr. WARNER (for himself and Mr. WEBB) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
Transportation

A BILL

To remove restrictions from a parcel of land situated in
the Atlantic District, Accomack County, Virginia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS.**

4 (a) REMOVAL.—Not later than 90 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
6 shall execute such instruments as may be necessary to re-
7 move all deed restrictions described in subsection (b) relat-
8 ing to the parcel of land described in subsection (c).

9 (b) DEED RESTRICTIONS.—The deed restrictions re-
10 ferred to in subsection (a) are those restrictions, including

1 easements, exceptions, reservations, terms, conditions, and
2 covenants described in Quitclaim Deed No. 17808A from
3 the United States to Accomack County, Virginia, executed
4 on December 20, 1976, and recorded among the real es-
5 tate records of Accomack County, Virginia, by the Clerk
6 of the Circuit Court, on pages 292 through 296 of Deed
7 Book 381.

8 (c) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcel of land re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) consists of approximately 31.6
10 acres situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County,
11 Virginia, more particularly described in the metes and
12 bounds description recorded on page 292 of the quitclaim
13 deed described in subsection (b).
