To extend certain privileges and immunities to the Gulf
Cooperation Council.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PRIVILEGES AND IM-**
4 **MUNITIES TO THE GULF COOPERATION**
5 **COUNCIL.**

6 The International Organizations Immunities Act (22
7 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the
8 following new section:

9 “SEC. 18. Under such terms and conditions as the
10 President shall determine, the President is authorized to
11 extend the provisions of this title to the Cooperation Coun-

1 cil for the Arab States of the Gulf to the same extent,
2 and subject to the same conditions, as they may be ex-
3 tended to a public international organization in which the
4 United States participates pursuant to any treaty or under
5 the authority of any Act of Congress authorizing such par-
6 ticipation or making an appropriation for such participa-
7 tion.”.

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
