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## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to improve dependent coverage under the TRICARE Young Adult Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Care Fairness  
5 for Military Families Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENTS TO DEPENDENT COVERAGE**  
7 **UNDER TRICARE YOUNG ADULT PROGRAM.**

8 (a) EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY.—Subsection (b) of  
9 section 1110b of title 10, United States Code, is amend-  
10 ed—

1 (1) by striking paragraph (3); and

2 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as  
3 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively.

4 (b) ELIMINATION OF SEPARATE PREMIUM FOR A  
5 YOUNG ADULT.—Such section is further amended by  
6 striking subsection (c).

7 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 1075(e)(3)  
8 of such title is amended by striking “section 1076d,  
9 1076e, or 1110b” and inserting “section 1076d or  
10 1076e”.

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
